

## Depression in Adolescents and Children: Differences and Interventions for Teachers & Parents Dan Weinstein, Psy.D.

The purpose of this presentation is to provide current, evidence-based information about the various types of Mood Disorders (Major Depressive Disorder, Bipolar Disorder, & Dysthymic Disorder). Dr. Weinstein will review the prevalence of depressive disorders and issues related to onset of depression and suicide. Risk factors for depression will be discussed, as well as the diagnostic criteria and symptoms of depression, with a special focus on signs that may be associated with depressive disorders that are specific to children and adolescents.

Dr. Weinstein will describe the etiology and evaluation of depression, as well as the various treatments that are effective in reducing depression. He will provide techniques for helping depressed adolescents and children receive the help they need. If time permits he will demystify myths about depression in this population and discuss the co-occurrence of depression and other conditions (e.g., anxiety, AD/HD).
